This year we...

Responded quickly, creatively and compassionately to the needs of our community as the pandemic hit through the "Creation in isolation" programme

Delivered food parcels and creative care packs to the Malcolm X Elders and Making Time participants

Created and nurtured partnerships with FareShare, Bristol Community Transport and local schools to reach those in need

Created and published over 30 films: including the "Films from Lockdown" series that premiered in July 2021

Continued to deliver seminars and CPD as part of Cornerstone, as well as new initiative "Sandbox", resulting in 22 new concepts

Creation in Isolation Project | Katie Delaney March - July 2020

Partnering with organisations FareShare and Bristol Community Transport to provide food parcels to our participants and those in need.

Over the months of Lockdown one, the team - led by Katie - helped Bristol Community Transport deliver hundreds of food parcels across the city, using food from charity FareShare.

After completing five in person workshops back in 2020, the acta team decided to offer two courses virtually.










The Virtual Seminar acta & Cornerstone 2020 - 2021
